Hints For Parents, Teachers and Pupils



PARENTS

- 1. Show a constant interest in your child's work.
- 2. Have your children take lessons regularly.
- 3. Supervise your child's practice.
- 4. If possible sit in while your child practices.
- 5. Please understand that different children progress at different rates of speed.
- 6. Be sympathetic and patient with your child.
- 7. Be tolerant try to understand the teacher's problems.

TEACHERS

- 1. Be enthusiastic. Enthusiasm is the spark of life.
- 2. See that your pupil experiences the feeling of success.
- 3. Thoroughness is important not speed.
- 4. Be kind, sympathetic and patient.
- 5. Keep your interest in new methods and new materials.
- 6. Colorful and vivid teaching is best.
- 7. Adjust your teaching to suit the individual differences and needs of your pupils.





PUPILS

- 1. Early practice is best.
- 2. Practice slowly until the lesson is mastered.
- 3. Practice hands separately at first, then together.
- 4. Play with a beautiful tone.
- 5. Be careful and thorough.
- 6. Develop a little repertoire.
- 7. Count aloud not just to yourself.
- 8. Always be relaxed. Avoid tension.
